

Presidential Pause on Grant, Loan, and Other Financial Assistance Programs (Update 1/30/25)

January 30, 2025

As was widely publicized yesterday afternoon, the Office of Management and Budget has rescinded the temporary pause on federal financial assistance payments. While it was believed the pause was not going to impact SBA lending, as with many things that happen in Washington, interpretations can vary. Thank you for your patience and we look forward to continuing to serve Michigan's small businesses.

According to public news sources, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has issued a new <u>memo</u> rescinding its temporary pause on federal financial assistance.

This means CDCs and their third-party lending partners can continue delivering 504 loans and CA loans to small businesses.
